

Marshes' memories

ST THOMAS' Church in Doxey is to host a history day about the area's marshes.

Organised by Staffordshire Wildlife Trust and Staffordshire County Council's youth service, Memories of the Marshes will be staged on Saturday between 11am and 4pm.

Doxey youngsters have prepared by recording elderly residents' memories of playing in the marshes as children, catching crayfish and newts, hiring boats to sail up the River Sow and being taught how to collect wild food by Polish prisoners of war.
